

<p>Description of Activity/Club/Event:</p>	<p>The award scheme is designed to recognise young people for the physical activities, skills and volunteering opportunities they may already be involved in, or encourage them to take part in new experiences or opportunities. One element of the award is the expedition section. This involves a minimum of 2 days physical activity (e.g. a hike or hill walk) and 1 night of camping.</p> <p>The Duke of Edinburgh's award is internationally recognised and is highly valued by employers and further or higher education institutions.</p>

Some items are available for hire. Pupils are required to source their own activities and keep a detailed log of them. Participants are also required to upload their evidence onto the award scheme's electronic system in order to receive their final award.</p>

<p>Description of Activity/Club/Event:</p>	<p>Every year, Sgoil Lionacleit pupils produce a film for the annual Film G competition. Each year there is a theme and schools across the country are invited to produce a film entry. This is a hands-on activity where pupils can develop all sorts of skills including script writing, operating filming equipment and using editing software. If another competition arises such as the Thank You Awards or the Commonwealth Games competition, the club will aim to produce another entry.</p>

<p>Description of Activity/Club/Event:</p>	<p>This one-off course is taught by Mrs Esther MacDonald and financed by the Environmental Health Department. It teaches pupils about food hygiene, food contamination, food poisoning, food handling and legal requirements. A multiple choice test is conducted at the end of the course, with results issued within a few days. A certificate will be issued in about 6 weeks. The certificate is valid for 3 years.</p>




