





Description of Activity/Club/Event:	<p>The Award Scheme is designed to recognise young people for the physical activities, skills and volunteering opportunities they may already be involved in, or encourage them to take part in new experiences or opportunities. One element of the award is the expedition section. This involves a minimum of 2 days physical activity (e.g. a hike or hill walk) and 1 night of camping.</p> <p>The Duke of Edinburgh's Award is internationally recognised and is highly valued by employers and further or higher education institutions.</p>
